

UPDATES TO OUR UNIFORM POLICY

Dear Parent/Carer

In response to feedback from parents & carers, we are making two changes to our PE Kit & Uniform policy.

1. GIRLS CAN WEAR LEGGINGS FOR PE

- If worn for PE, leggings must be **plain black**. No branding or 'fashion accessorising' is allowed.

So, our PE Kit is now as follows:

- Plain black shorts (boys & girls), or gym skirt or leggings for girls. No bicycle shorts and no football strip shorts. Note that plain black jogging bottoms can be worn in the colder months (boys & girls).
- Plain white t-shirt.
- Trainers or plimsolls. Please avoid black soles if possible...or get the ones that don't mark floors.

2. FOR DAILY UNIFORM, GIRLS CAN WEAR LEGGINGS AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO TIGHTS, IF PARENTS WISH, BUT THESE MUST BE WORN WITH A SKIRT OR DRESS

- **Plain black** leggings only. No fashion or branded items.
- Must be worn under a skirt or dress.
- If leggings are worn, black socks (not white or coloured socks) to be worn, please.

So, our Uniform is now as follows:

Girls

- Royal blue sweatshirt, v-neck jumper or cardigan.
- White or blue polo shirt (or traditional collared shirt if you prefer, in white).
- Grey or black skirt or trousers, or grey dress/pinafore – note that an acceptable alternative would be a blue Gingham Dress.
- Tights or leggings – **worn with a skirt or dress**.
- Black shoes or black shoe/trainer crossovers (not colourful/coloured trainers). Boots are fine in the winter, if you wish.

Boys

- Royal blue sweatshirt or v-neck jumper.
- White or blue polo shirt (or traditional collared shirt if you prefer, in white).
- Grey or black shorts or trousers.
- Black shoes or black shoe/trainer crossovers (not colourful/coloured trainers).
